### **Theme Description:**

Eureka is a classic web 2.0 styled theme for Wordpress. It can be used for a regular blog or as a CMS. It has a standard two column layout using 960.gs CSS framework.

Templates for archives, categories, as well as a bonus home page template with coda slider already built in. The single post page has social buttons integrated, paginated and multi-threaded comments with gravatars. The sidebar is fully widgetized, with custom styling to match the rest of the theme. Eureka is built for Wordpress 2.7, tested in browsers: Internet Explorer 6, 7 and Firefox.

### **Known IE 6 issues:**

Page Navigation in header (Rounded corners) is cutoff

Subscribe and Twitter button in sidebar shows an “x” with borders

Border in Footer Credits disappears

### **Included in the download:**

### **Installation Instructions:**

Upload and extract **Eureka.zip** to your Wordpress themes directory: wordpress root > Wp-content > themes. Activate the theme in the admin panel (Appearance > Themes > Select "**Eureka**" and "**activate**" in preview.

### **Customization Instructions:**

#### **How to edit the “Twitter” button in the Sidebar**

- From the Wordpress Admin Menu – go to “**Appearance**” > “**Editor**”.
- Select the file: “**Sidebar.php**” look for 2 strings: <a href="#">.
- Replace “#” with your **RSS feed link** (Feedburner) and your **Twitter profile link**
- Click “**Update File**”

\*Note the original .psd file for the image is included in the eureka-final.zip named **sidebar-btns-twitter.psd**

#### **How to add thumbnails to your post through custom fields**

- Create a new post
- Scroll down to section “**Custom Fields**”, click “**Enter New**”
- Enter “**image**” under the name, “**image url**” in the value
- Publish your post

\*Note the image url is the absolute location of your image – you can use Wordpress media uploader to upload your image and get the photo url by clicking “**file url**”

\*The thumbnail sizes is by default **150 pixels x 150 pixels**

#### **How to use tables in your posts:**

- Eureka will only style the tables you use if you use class=”datatable”
- Your editor should be switched to “**HTML**” view, once table is entered – look for the table opening tag “<table>” and append “**class=“datatable”**” in between the < and >
- For the table row headers – append “**class=“doubleborders”**” – look for the first “<td>” tag and include “**class=“doubleborders”**” in between <td and >

#### **How to edit the advertising images and links**

- From the Wordpress Admin Menu – go to “**Appearance**” > “**Editor**”
- Look for the file: “**Sidebar.php**”, under the list: `<ul class="ads-spot">`
- Change the value of the link: `<a href="#">` (#) with your url
- Change the value of the image source: `` (#) with your image url

### **How to add widgets to your sidebar**

- From the Wordpress Admin Menu – go to “**Appearance**” > “**Widgets**”
- Choose the widget you like and click “**Add**”
- Click “**Save Changes**” in the right side

\*Note that your widgets will appear above the Search form in the sidebar. The Widget titles and lists are designed to match the rest of the theme.

### **How to change the logo**

- Replace the file named “**logo.png**” inside the eureka\images folder
- The dimensions of the logo: 250 pixels by 79 and has to be in .png format with transparent background
- The .psd file is included in the eureka-final.zip named: **logo.psd**

### **How to activate the static home page template**

- In your Wordpress Admin Panel, Create a new page: under “**Pages**” > “**Add New**”
- In the right hand side – under “**Template**” choose: “**template-home**”
- Publish your page

Make your new page the home page for your website:

- Go to **Settings > Reading**
- Under “**Front Page Displays**”, select “**A static page**”
- Select the newly created homepage from the drop-down lists under “**Front Page**”
- Click “**Save Changes**”

### **How to change the Subscribe Section in the Home page template**

- From the Wordpress Admin Menu – go to “**Appearance**” > “**Editor**”
- Select the file “**subscribe.php**”
- Replace the # in the strings: `<a href="#">` with your information
- Click “**Update File**”

## How to change the Testimonials Section in the Home page template

- From the Wordpress Admin Menu – go to “**Appearance**” > “**Editor**”
- Select the file “**testimonials.php**”
- Replace the strings in between <p> and </p> tags for the testimonials
- Enter the testimonial author in between the <strong> and </strong> tags
- Click “**Update File**”

## How to change the Feature Slider Images

- The original .psd file for the Coda Slider is included in the **eureka-final.zip**. This photoshop file is grouped and layered by slide number. Edit the layers (images and text) accordingly.
  - You are going to replace the images inside the eureka\images folder named:
    - slide-1.png
    - slide-2.png
    - slide-3.png
    - slide-4.png
    - slide-5.png
- \*IMPORTANT: that slide dimensions are at 940 pixels x 536 pixels and should be transparent to preserve the background of the theme
